Below is a list of contest rules for the 2024-2025 Hunting Season

- 1.) Contest dates are October 1, 2024 thru February 15, 2025 (If you are hunting early velvet week season, you must be entered prior).
- 2.) Any legally harvested whitetail buck deer may be entered into the overall contest.

We will have 2 divisions: A Louisiana and an Out of State division with equal prizes(1st, 2nd & 3rd place in each), you are only allowed to win in one division.

3.) All deer entered, must be harvested by contestant participant, along with a picture with the antlers on the animal.

4.) Deer harvested from a guided hunt, contractor owned leases or high fenced ranches will NOT be eligible.

5.) Scoring will be by appointment and scored by Nathan Poche (CAB 255) and Jay Alleman(West Site 985-817-1043).

Scoring will be done using the BUCKMASTERS scoring with inside spread included.

(No Deductions)

6.) Contestants may enter more than one deer taken during the 2024-2025 season, but only the highest scoring buck will be eligible to win one prize in its category.

7.) All participants have a chance at winning one of the places which will be awarded in the Overall contest.

All participants will be eligible to attend the banquet at the Employee's Club Building, and have a chance to win a door prize, **(Must attend to win door prize). (This excludes employees having to work you will still be eligible to win.)**

8) There will be two equal Grand Prize drawings at the banquet.

Drawing #1 will include all participants entering a scorable buck. Drawing #2 will include ALL participants less drawing #1 winner.
